Introduction

Minerals are a valuable natural resource being the vital raw material for infrastructure, capital goods and basic industries. As a major resource for development, the extraction and management of minerals has to be integrated into the overall strategy of the country's economic development. As the country develops and industry grows, assured availability and proximity of mineral resources will play an important role in giving a competitive edge to Indian industry. The multiplier effect of minerals processed into

metals on downstream industrialization cannot be over emphasized.

Due to the new emphasis on low-carbon and green technologies, there is also a significant shift in the demand for new kinds of metals commonly called technology metals and Energy Critical Metals. To ensure “Make in India” becomes a reality, it is imperative to grow the mining sector by vigorous and intensive exploration using the latest technologies.

To “Mine in India” we must first “Explore in India”. India is far behind in expenditure on mineral exploration. It accounts for only 0.3% of global exploration budget compared with over 19% by Canada, 12% by Australia, 7% by United States, and 4.5% by China. Exploration in India is mostly limited to a depth of 50-100 meter as compared to 300 meters in countries such as Australia which call for advance underground mining technology and new mining techniques.

With this background, **ASSOCHAM** is organizing its annual “India Mining Summit” on 20th July 2018 at **Hotel The Imperial, New Delhi**. The theme of the summit is ‘Mine in India to Make in India’.
