The Aviation industry in India has emerged as one of the fastest growing industries in the country during the last three years. India is currently considered the third largest domestic civil aviation market in the world and is expected to become the world's largest domestic civil aviation market in the next 10 to 15 years. Around one-fifth of the country's airports have reached saturation point, across tier-II airports and Metro airports like Mumbai. - ⊙ **Panel discussion on Development of Cargo Hub in India:** The discussion will cover the need for dedicated cargo hub in India, key policy interventions required to bolster the growth of cargo industry and role of technological advances with a focus on infrastructure and policy requirements to develop the cargo market in India.
