







Supply chain disruptions can lead to production delays, shortages, increased prices, reduced economic activity, etc. To handle the disruptions and challenges in the sector, the government of India came up with a new logistics policy which has been taken by the government in terms of the PM Gati Shakti Plan, which integrates and complements the new logistics policy. The government is focused on simplifying regulations, reducing compliance burdens, and promoting ease of doing business to attract investment and facilitate smoother operations. By focusing on infrastructure development, regulatory reforms, digitalization, skill development, and fostering collaboration, India can overcome these challenges and strengthen its logistics ecosystem, contributing to economic growth and competitiveness.
