India wins bid to host international conference on cement in 2027

India has won the bid to host the International Congress on the Chemistry of Cement (ICCC) in 2027, beating out competition from the UAE and Switzerland. The conference, which reviews research progress in the cement and concrete sector, is held every four to six years and is the largest event of its kind.
