Samsung in talks with Airtel, VIL to build 5G network

DoT to allocate two carriers of 250 MHz each in E-band

South Korean company Samsung entered India's telecom gear market by winning the contract to build Reliance Jio's pan-India 4G network. The company is now looking beyond Jio in 5G. It is in talks with Bharti Airtel and Vodafone Idea.

DoT announced that it would allot a maximum of two carriers of 250 MHz each in the E band

to telecom firms for backhaul of towers, or connection between cell towers, a move that would remove a major impediment and accelerate the country's rollout of 5G networks.

Jio highest bidder in 5G spectrum auction

The largest telecom spectrum auction in India received a record Rs.1.5 trillion of bids, with Jio capturing nearly half of all airwaves sold with a Rs.880.7 billion bid, for 24,740 MHz of airwaves across five bands capable of providing speeds up to 10 times faster than 4G.




