## India-UK FTA to be signed post UK elections

The India-United Kingdom free trade agreement (FTA) is slated to be signed following the UK's elections. To date, 13 rounds of negotiations have been concluded, with a focus on tariff reductions and resolving regulatory issues. Both parties are working towards finalising the FTA to boost bilateral trade, which currently stands at GBP 38.1 billion per year.
