#### Two new power transmission lines for Mumbai

Two new transmission lines between Kharghar and Vikhroli, and Kudus and Aarey Colony are expected to commission in December 20223 and December 2026, respectively. With these, the transmission capacity of Mumbai will expand to around 4.3 GW from 2.3 GW at present.

Maharashtra GSDP to grow at 12.1%: State economic survey

The Gross State Domestic Product in Maharashtra is being anticipated to grow at 12.1 per cent in 2021-22, as against the negative eight per cent recorded in 2020-21. The nominal GSDP is likely to be Rs. 31 trillion and real GSDP at constant prices will be Rs. 21.1 trillion.

### PM inaugurates Pune Metro rail project in Maharashtra

PM Narendra Modi inaugurated the Pune Metro rail project, including two priority stretches of 12-km. The project is being built at a total cost of more than Rs. 114 billion. Besides this, he also unveiled a statue of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj at the Pune Municipal Corporation.
