# Punjab

The corporation has also made power purchase arrangements (PPA) of nearly 500 MW on a short-term basis from June to September 2022.

The minister praised Gujarat's cooperative sector for making invaluable contributions by providing equal development opportunities to the poor, farmers, women and youth. It would play a crucial role in fulfilling the Centre's mission of developing a self-reliant nation along with doubling the income of farmers.

SJVN secures 100 MW solar power project in Gujarat

The state-owned power producer, SJVN, has secured a 100 MW grid-connected solar power project in Gujarat through tariff-based competitive bidding held by Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam (GUVNL). The project will generate 245.28 million units of power every year and is expected to generate cumulative energy of around 6,132 million units over the next 25 years. The project is estimated to cost around Rs.5 billion.



# Maharashtra



The Maharashtra government is looking to offer incentives for setting up more liquid medical oxygen units in the state, in the wake of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. This has come as the state government has estimated that the requirement of liquid medical oxygen could go up to 2,300 metric tonnes (MT) a day in the future.

# Madhya Pradesh

Centre sanctions Rs. 8.7 bln for upgradation of 2 roads in Madhya Pradesh

The Centre has sanctioned an amount to the tune of Rs. 8.7 billion for the upgradation of as many as two roads in Madhya Pradesh. Notably, these roads are important from the point of view of tourism in the state. The development will provide better road connectivity from Sanchi to Chanderi and from Kanha National Park to the origin of Narmada river Amarkantak, besides helping tourists visiting the fossil park in Raipura.

### Tamil Nadu

Chennai to get second airport

Chennai is set to get second airport. Preliminary work on the location for a second airport for Chennai has begun with the Airports Authority of India (AAI) inspecting four potential sites identified by the Tamil Nadu government for setting up the greenfield facility. The four sites that the state government has suggested for the Chennai's second airport are Tirupporur, Parandur, Pannur, Padalam.

### **Andhra Pradesh**

Andhra Pradesh's economy fully-recovered from pandemic's impact: Survey

Andhra Pradesh's economy has fully-recovered from the impact of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, according to the Socio-Economic Survey 2021-22. The Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) at current prices stands at Rs. 12 trillion, as against Rs. 10.1 trillion in 2020-21. At constant prices, the GSDP grew at 11.4 per cent to Rs. 6.7 trillion.

In a bid to encourage more women to take up driving in the Delhi Transport Corporation, the Delhi government has allowed joint ownership of electric autorickshaws (e-autos). As part of this, 33 per cent e-autos have been reserved for women and height restrictions have also been relaxed, informed transport minister Kailash Gahlot.

### **Uttar Pradesh**

Greater Noida Authority allocates Rs. 11 bln for Noida-Greater Noida Metro works

Uttar Pradesh's Greater Noida Authority has allocated a sum of Rs. 11 billion for the Noida-Greater Noida Metro works. The project is likely to be completed by the end of 2024. In the first phase, the Metro will cover Sector-51 to Sector-2 of Greater Noida West. As many as five elevated stations will be built on the 9.1-km-long-elevated track. The GR Infra Project Limited has taken up the project.

UP power discoms to raise debt worth Rs.80 billion before 31 March

The Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation (UPPC) will be issuing bonds worth Rs.80 billion before 31 March 2022, to bridge the gap between its revenues and operational expenses. The government-backed bonds will be traded on the BSE portal with a required minimum investment of Rs.1 million

# Rajasthan

Married daughters to get job on compassionate grounds in Rajasthan Roadways

The Rajasthan government has approved the proposal of Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation (RSRTC) enabling married daughters to get job in the state roadways on compassionate grounds in case of her father's death. Earlier, there was a provision to give compassionate appointments to the dependents on the death of the employee in the corporation, including sons, adopted sons, unmarried daughters, divorced daughters, widowed daughters or wife.

# West Bengal

### Odisha

OSRTC replaces 86 buses with modern fleet in Odisha

The Odisha State Road Transport Corporation (OSRTC) has replaced as many as 86 old buses with modern ones on 46 existing routes across the state. The aim is to provide better comfort and safety to the passengers.

# Jharkhand

Companies in Jharkhand urged to utilise 2% profits for welfare activities

Companies in Jharkhand have been urged to spend at least two per cent of their profits for welfare activities and development of public amenities. The appeal was made by state transport minister Champai Soren, on 13 March 2022. The minister also demanded the Tata Steel Foundation to provide 1,500 e-scooters to the Sahiya Didis who work in the remote & difficult terrains.

Jharkhand's new airport in Deoghar all set to begin operations

Jharkhand's newly-constructed airport in Deoghar is likely to begin operations after receiving a nod from the Directorate General of Civil Aviation. The airport has been completed by the Airports Authority of India (AAI). It is spread over an area of 263 hectares and has a capacity to handle 200 passengers at peak hours. The terminal building also has tribal arts, handicrafts and local tourist sites. It is equipped with contemporary amenities such as round-the-clock medical assistance for passengers, six check-in counters, etc.
