Punjab

Nearly 50 toll plazas in Punjab and Haryana have been shut for six-eight months, in view of the ongoing farmers' protests against the three farm laws of the Centre. Following this, the central government has suffered losses worth Rs. 20 billion, so far.

At least 53 patients have died of black fungus infection in the last 56 days at a government-run hospital in Madhya Pradesh's Indore city. An analysis of this data has revealed that the mortality rate of black fungus patients at the hospital stands at 8%.

Telangana

Telangana govt sets aside Rs. 3.1 bln for boosting healthcare facilities

The Telangana government has earmarked a total of Rs. 3.1 billion for boosting healthcare facilities in the state. The move has come with an aim to equip the medical infrastructure in government hospitals ahead of a possible third wave of COVID-19.
