Andhra Pradesh govt to reintroduce Free Sand Scheme

The Andhra Pradesh government has decided to reintroduce the Free Sand Scheme in the next three months. The initiative was implemented five years ago during the last Telugu Desam (TDP) regime. Chief Minister (CM) N Chandrababu Naidu has directed state mines minister Kollu Ravindra to ensure smooth implementation of the scheme.

Bihar

Bihar moves Supreme Court against Patna High Court order quashing 65 per cent quota

The Bihar government moved the Supreme Court, challenging the Patna High Court's directive to 'set aside' the increase in the State's reservation for disadvantaged communities, from the existing 50 per cent to 65 per cent. This is the quota for Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs), extremely backward classes (EBCs), and other backward classes (OBCs) in government jobs and educational institutions.

Seventh bridge collapses in Bihar in 15 days

A bridge over the Gandaki river in Siwan district, Bihar, collapsed on Wednesday morning, marking the seventh such incident in the state within the past 15 days. The bridge, located in Deoria block, connects several villages with Mahrajganj. No casualties have been reported. This is the second bridge collapse in Siwan within the last 11 days.



Gujarat



Gujarat's GST collection registers 14 per cent growth during April-June

Gujarat's revenue from GST collection stood at INR296.2 billion during April-June 2024. This is higher than INR260.6 billion collected in the same period last year, registering 14 per cent year-on-year growth.

The Haryana government has decided to release INR16.69 crore to those adopting direct-seeded rice (DSR) technique. The amount will be given to farmers in nine districts, covering an area of 16,886 hectares. The DSR technique does not require flooded fields for paddy seeding.

The Rajasthan cabinet gave its approval for a greenfield airport in Kota and an aerocity in Jaipur with an investment of INR2 lakh crore.


