#### Andhra Pradesh's APSRTC fixes commercial revenue target of INR500 crore

The Andhra Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation (APSRTC) has fixed a commercial revenue target of INR 500 crore for 2024-25. Of the total, the APSRTC is expecting to generate INR320 crore through its logistics wing, INR 130 crore from the rent paid for the stalls put up by private persons in the bus stations.

#### GETCO to spend INR96,000 crore to build transmission infrastructure

The Gujarat Energy Transmission Corporation (GETCO) has decided to spend nearly INR96,000 crore to build transmission infrastructure within the state over the next eight years. The move aims to evacuate the growing renewable energy capacity in the state. At present, the state has around 11,823 MW of wind and 14,182 MW of solar capacities.
